# TRUTH Quest

## Is it Scientific Fact, Theory, or FAITH?

Lots of people get Science confused with Faith. When this happens, we can get confused about God, and that's not good. Use this chart to help you find out whether something is Scientific Fact, Theory, or Faith. If you need help, have Mom or Dad help you.

If someone makes a statement...

You Ask, "How do you know?"

If they say, "It's a scientific fact!"

If they say, "It's a theory."

If they say, "I have faith!"

You Ask, "Can you prove it with an experiment?"

If they say, "Yes!"

If they say, "No."

You Say, "Please show me."

If they show you the experiment, or if they tell you about an experiment...

If they say they can't show you an experiment...

And if that experiment can be watched and repeated and it always agrees with what the person says...

But if that experiment can't be watched, or can't be repeated, or doesn't always agree with what the person says...

This means that it REALLY IS a Scientific Fact! You can believe it!

This means that it's NOT a scientific fact. (go to box #3.)

3. This means that it's NOT a scientific fact, because it can't be proven with an experiment.

You Ask, "Are you positive you're right?"

If they say, "No."

If they say, "Yes!"

This means that it's REALLY a Theory. (go to box #1.)

This means that it's REALLY Faith. (go to box #2.)

1. This means that the person can't be sure that they're right, because they can't prove it with an experiment.

This means that it's up to you whether or not you believe what the person said is right or wrong.

2. This means that the person feels very sure that they're right, because they believe it by faith.

If you have faith in the same thing that the person has faith in, you'll believe what they said.

If you DON'T have faith in the same thing that the person has faith in, you won't believe what they said.

NOTE: You can have faith in just about anything, but most things aren't worthy of your faith!
